Water Management/Water Quality Newsletter

Raymond and Steve presented the Water Management/Water Quality Newsletter to the Community Representatives.

Russell asked what was currently being done to clean-up Grassy Lake. He had heard that someone might have up to \$10 million for improvements, maybe DNR.

Raymond responded by discussing the detailed studies and data collection we will be completing and that we will follow-up and try to dig down into who might be reviewing opportunities to clean-up Grassy Lake.

Alice wondered whether we were looking at historical data since current conditions are so abnormally dry.

Raymond indicated we are collecting historical and current data from the area.

Martha asked whether we had collected specific studies about the area – answer is yes we have those and are reviewing those.

Raymond indicated we are reviewing the pollutant and algal bloom monitoring data as all of these factors are related.

Alice indicated that the protection should be better than what was provided for Lake Jackson and Meginnis Arm.

It was noted that the flow was restored between the Delta parcel and the chain of lakes – it had previously, for a short time been stopped through man-made activities.

Blueprint's plan is to remove the fill that was previously brought into the Delta parcel.

It was suggested that all acronyms and abbreviations be removed from the Newsletter.

The concern about water quality does not stop when the water enters the sink. It then becomes ground water and ultimately drinking water. The newsletter should identify the aquifer as the discharge from Ame's sink.

It was suggested that the PD&E Study consider vegetative ponds as a solution – the plan should look to remove nutrients before dealing with volume control.

Comments and concerns were noted about the affects of Lake Henrietta – particularly on Lake Munson – the Water Resource Committee is scheduled to discuss Lake Munson at its meeting next month.

Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission will not remove the sediment because of continuous flow problems. Steve Hodges and staff will discuss this at next month's meeting of the Water Resource Committee.

Airport has concern over anything that attracts wildlife – the use of the Broadmoor parcel as a pond is of particular concern.

There are many sinks in the area – these must be noted, studied and understood.

A different plan, other than the big deep pond, is need because of the sinks in the area.

Mimic nature as much as possible to preserve and serve the stormwater needs.
