Notes

The meeting began at 5:30 PM. Raymond Ashe started the meeting thanking the CRs for their time commitments up to this point. Raymond introduced the new Blueprint 2000 staff and stated that the search for a permanent replacement for Paul Heirs was in the process.

Evaluation Criteria

Raymond Ashe began the discussion by describing the weighting system and the numbers given were his suggestions based on reviewing the materials from previous public involvement activities. This is the CR's opportunity to discuss the weighting criteria for each issue.

Raymond discussed each issue beginning with Floodplains and concluding with Residential Neighborhoods. The current weighting summary is three number threes, five number twos and five numbers ones. Raymond stated that each issue should not be weighted as a 3 otherwise it would negate the purpose of the weighting effort. Some of the most important community issues raised by the CR include:

- Environmental protection (wetlands should get a higher number)
- Access and Mobility
- Springhill Road should be a Gateway to Downtown
- Including Life-Cycle Cost analysis in the Cost Estimate

Below is a table showing the original weighting developed by Blueprint and Consultant and the suggested changes by the CR. The third and fourth columns show the TCC and CAC recommendations and the fifth column shows the approved weighting by the Intergovernmental Agency at the September 17, 2007 meeting. The differences between the original criteria weighting and the approved criteria weighting are highlighted in yellow.
