



The purpose of the roadway improvement project is to increase the capacity and safety of the existing highway. 





### **Project Description:**

A Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) Study will be conducted for that portion of Capital Circle (SR 263) between Crawfordville Road (SR 61 US 319) and Blountstown Highway (SR 20) a distance of approx. 6.7 miles. The PD&E study will be conducted in accordance with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Blueprint 2000 Agency, and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) guidelines. The study will evaluate alternative corridors as well as the existing corridor. Several viable alternatives will be developed and evaluated in order to address the project needs while taking into account the Blueprint 2000 & Beyond "Project Definitions Report", prepared by the Economic and Environmental Consensus Committee in 1999, and the Lake Bradford Sector Plan, conducted by the Tallahassee/Leon County Planning Department.




**RESOLUTION** 

URS has completed the design and analysis for the ponds located in Basins 2 and 3 within the Flea Market Tract. The ponds have been surveyed and a legal description has been provided to USFS and Leon County.







### **Right-Of-Way Status Report:**

The Flea Market Tract is owned by the United States Forest Service (USFS). It appears that the acquisition by Leon County is the most logical and appropriate solution. To accomplish this USFS will need to present legislation to the federal government that would allow USFS to sell this site. If this legislation is approved, USFS has agreed to sell this parcel to Leon County less the land necessary for right-of-way and drainage improvements. The purchase price for Leon County will be determined by appraised value. This value will be based upon the remaining acreage; further USFS has agreed to provide Blueprint with a right-of-way and drainage easements (at no cost to Blueprint) for the E-3 project and Blueprint is concurrently proceeding with submitting an application to USFS. Note: This easement application is not subject to the federal legislation being approved; and should the land be acquired by Leon County the easement application process with USFS will be unnecessary.







#### **Project Status:**

Erosion Control and Clearing and Grubbing work is complete from Tram Road to north of Monday Street. The EMP conditional permit for Segment 2 has been granted on October 31, 2005. Segment 2B EMP permit conditions have been satisfied and full permit for Segment 2 is in effect as of April 20, 2006. Conditional permit to place fill on Segment 3 has been granted by COT and DEP. Design of Segment 3 is more than 90% complete. Final plans for Segment 4 have been submitted to Blueprint for review and comments. The plans have been reviewed and the comments given to the D-B Team. The EMP permit for Segments 3 have been applied for. The permit for Segment 4 has been obtained on June 8, 2006. Placing of fill on Segment 3 is in progress. COT Utility relocation permit has been obtained for Segments 1, 3 and 4. Utility relocation permit has been obtained from Leon County for Tram Road widening sections (east and west of CCSE). Utilities have been relocated on Segments 1 and 2. Utility relocation on Segments 3 and 4 is in progress. Work on re-use water line installation is in progress. Placement of COT Water Utility potable waterline and storm drainage system is completed between Tram Road and BlairStone Road. Curb and gutter and structural asphalt has been placed on CCSE between Tram Road and Merchants Row Boulevard. Concrete curb and gutter, basecourse and structural asphalt have been completed on northbound lanes between Merchants Row Boulevard and BlairStone Road at the beginning of July. A section of Tram Road east of CCSE has been paved and open to traffic on August 7, 2006. Placing of drainage pipes and road construction on Tram Road west of CCSE has been started. No major erosion control, safety, or maintenance of traffic issues to date.

The temporary traffic signals have been installed at Merchants Row intersection, some temporary striping put down, and traffic has been switched over to the final CCSE Southbound lanes between Tram Road and Merchants Row Boulevard on February 6th. The DRB Meeting has been held on August 01.






