

The Blueprint Intergovernmental Agency is seeking applicants for two membership positions on the Blueprint Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC). The Blueprint CAC serves in an advisory capacity to the Blueprint Board of Directors (IA Board), comprised of the Tallahassee City Commissioners and Leon County Commissioners. It is the responsibility of the CAC to review work plans involving infrastructure projects, financial audits, and performance audits and to make recommendations to the Blueprint Intergovernmental Agency.

There are 14 members of the Blueprint CAC, which are appointed by the IA Board following submission of a CAC application, linked below. Members are expected to attend approximately 6 meetings per year, every 2-3 months. CAC members are also subject to the Florida Sunshine Law (Public Meetings and Public Records), and the Blueprint Ethics Policy.

For current vacancies, listed below, the term of service is three years beginning December 2020, with option for reappointment for a second, three-year term.

- Member from the Disability Community
- Member who is a Planner

Per the Blueprint CAC Bylaws, the IA Board shall take into consideration as part of the selection process those individuals that formerly served on the Economic and Environmental Citizens Committee (EECC), however, previous service on the EECC is not a requirement.

Applications must be submitted by close of business on Wednesday, November 4, 2020. Applications to fill the two CAC vacancies will be considered by the CAC at their November 19, 2020 meeting, and by the IA Board at their December 10, 2020 meeting.
